

ARTISTS ALLEY AGREEMENT FOR PAWCON 2026

Thank you for joining us at PAWCon 2026, taking place at the San José Doubletree Hotel, 2050 Gateway Pl, San José, CA from November 6th - 8th, 2026. Please read, understand, and sign this agreement with us to join us in our Artists Alley.

hereinafter "Artist" or "you", and PAWCon, Inc., hereinafter "PAWCon" or "we", for the event and dates mentioned above. During the event, PAWCon will be represented by our Artists Alley lead, hereinafter "AAL". This agreement is valid only for the listed specific event and dates.

PAWCon will provide to you one half table and one chair (a "table space") in our designated Artists Alley area for a single day on which the Artists Alley is open. If the number of Artists who have requested a table space for a particular day exceeds the number of available table spaces, PAWCon will allocate table spaces using a lottery system until all table spaces are allocated. Provision of a table space to you on any particular day does not guarantee or give you priority for any other day or for any particular table space. Table spaces are provided for an entire day; portions of a day are not refundable. You may request a table space on more than one day, although PAWCon may give preference to Artists who have not already received a table space in order to promote variety for our attendees. You agree not to let any other party use your table space unless approved by the AAL. You may not occupy more than one table space.

You must have a valid PAWCon convention membership and badge for the day on which you request and occupy a table space. You must not already be a dealer or merchant in our Shopping District. You must be at least eighteen (18) years of age on the day on which you request a table space.

You agree to pay PAWCon \$25 for each day on which we offer you a table space and you accept it. The AAL will advise on the proper method of payment.

You agree that PAWCon is not acting as your agent or representative, and all that transactions in which you engage are exclusively between you and your customer. Transactions must occur only at your table space and not elsewhere in the convention space or hotel. You are responsible for the provision of any materials or supplies that you may need, and no internet services or electricity are provided with your table space. You are responsible to ensure that you are in compliance with any requirements imposed by the State of California, the County of Santa Clara, or the City of San José for you to engage in business.

Before occupying any table space, you must provide the AAL a copy of a valid permanent or temporary Seller's Permit issued by the State of California. If you don't already have one, you can obtain one here:

You agree that all artworks which you offer to your customers at your table space are your own original work and are legal to offer for sale in the State of California. You agree not to offer for sale any artworks where you are not the artist, general merchandise, food or beverages, or services unrelated to art (e.g. massages). Since PAWCon is open to minors, you agree that any materials which you display openly at your table space must be suitable for all ages, and that any materials not suitable for minors will be covered and otherwise handled with appropriate discretion. You are responsible for determining if an attendee is of legal age to view or purchase any materials not suitable for minors. If you have any questions about the suitability of your items or display, please contact the AAL.

Any artworks that you offer must be contained within the area of your table space and must not block the aisles or access to any other table space, and may not be adhered to the walls or to any other surface. If any of the artworks that you offer involve audio or video, you agree to offer the artworks in such a manner that does not disturb the Artists at other table spaces. You are responsible for the transportation of any materials or supplies to and from your table space.

You agree that PAWCon is not liable for any losses or theft which may occur from your table space. We recommend that you not leave any items on your table space when you are not occupying it.

You acknowledge that PAWCon's code of conduct applies to you while you are participating in Artists Alley. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless PAWCon and any of its staff, volunteers, or attendees for any liabilities or injuries which may arise from your participation in Artists Alley.

The AAL or the PAWCon Board of Directors may request that you vacate your table space, without refund, at any time if, in their sole discretion, the activities in which you are engaging at your table space are in violation of this agreement, are otherwise inappropriate, or are damaging to other attendees' or Artists' enjoyment of the event or to the reputation of PAWCon or of our host facility.

In the event of any disputes arising from your participation in Artists Alley, the decisions of the PAWCon Board of Directors are final.
